- 4. Proposed location of the septic tank, field lines, lift tanks and pumps, and a letter of approval from Washington County, and/or any other required governmental agency.
- 5. An adequate sample of the exterior façade building materials to be used: siding materials, foundation coverings and any other samples as may be requested by the Architectural Committee.
- 6. A diagram of the roof design and roofing materials.
- 7. Exterior paint, stain, stone and mortar colors must be of an earth tone color and samples must be submitted to the Architectural Committee.
- 8. A diagram, including materials list, for decking, docks, steps and any other structures to be built on the lot.
- 9. A landscaping plan including all names and locations of proposed trees and shrubs and exterior landscape lighting.
- 10. A detailed list of windows and doors to be used, including manufacturer, style, model and composition.
- 11. Driveway location and composition, including material and color.
